- Q5. Who are your favorite preachers? Do you believe that some people see their preference of preachers as a badge of honor? Do some people use preachers as a test of our maturity or orthodoxy?
- Q6. In the sermon it was said that the church is the temple. What does that mean? What are the implications of this ?
- Q7. Is it possible that you have ever contributed to breaking the unity of the temple? When? What was it that you did?
